In Australia women and men are equal, you speak to a woman with the same respect as you would to a man. In Australia men and women do the same tasks, cleaning of the house, washing of dishes, clothes etc... are shared among the members of the family including a little help from yourself maybe!

3) **RESPECT**

Australians can be humorous, friendly, easy going people and believe in respect for each other, it is considered polite to say "PLEASE" and "THANK YOU" when asking for or receiving anything. Please remember to greet your Homestay hosts eg: Good morning, good day, hello and goodbye.

4) **MEALS**

You will receive 3 meals a day from your host, breakfast, a packed lunch and evening dinner with the family.

5) **LAUNDRY**

Your host family will wash all your dirty laundry for you, just ask where you must put your laundry to be washed.

6) **TOILETRIES**

The host family will provide Soap only in the bathrooms, all other toiletries for example, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo and deodorants must be provided by yourself.

7) **BATHROOMS**

If you wish to make international calls from the home telephone you should purchase an international telephone card – see Reception upon arrival for more information.

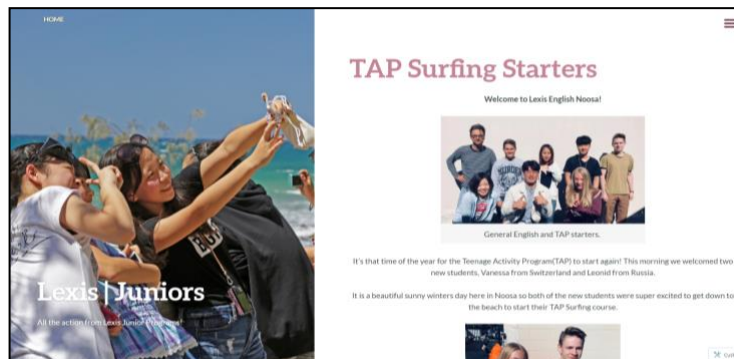

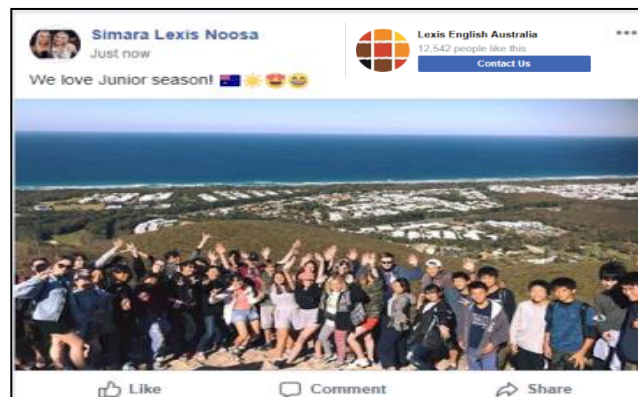
